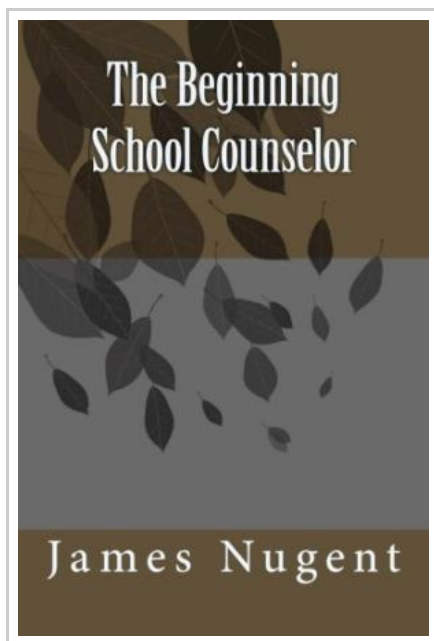




The Beginning School Counselor (Paperback)
