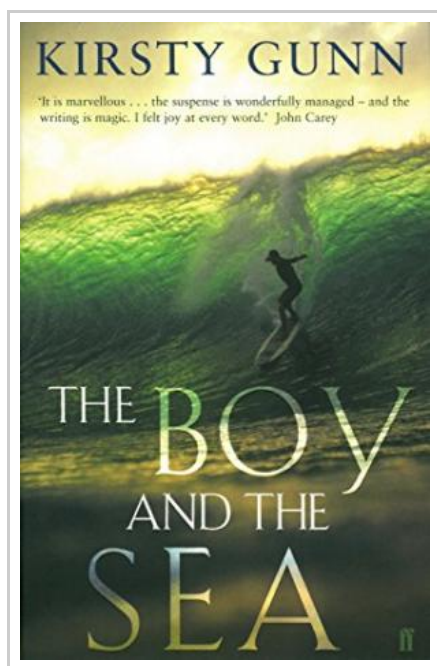




The Boy and the Sea
