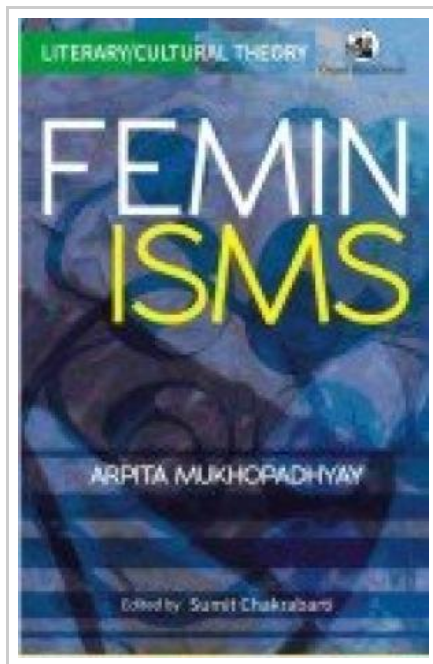




Feminisms
