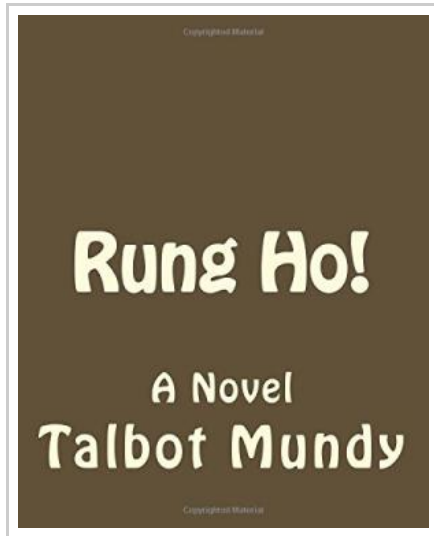




Rung Ho! (Paperback)
