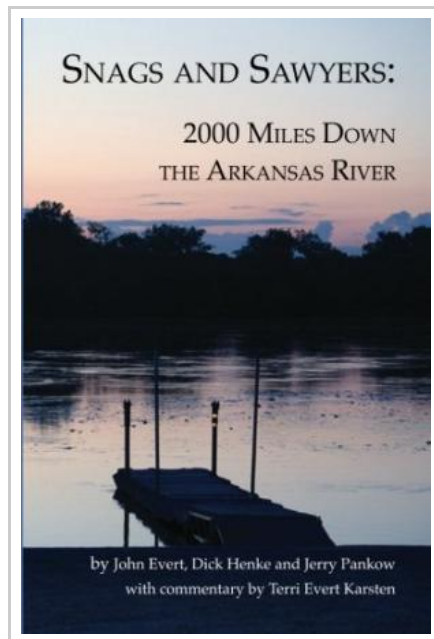




Snags and Sawyers: 2000 Miles Down the Arkansas River (Paperback)
