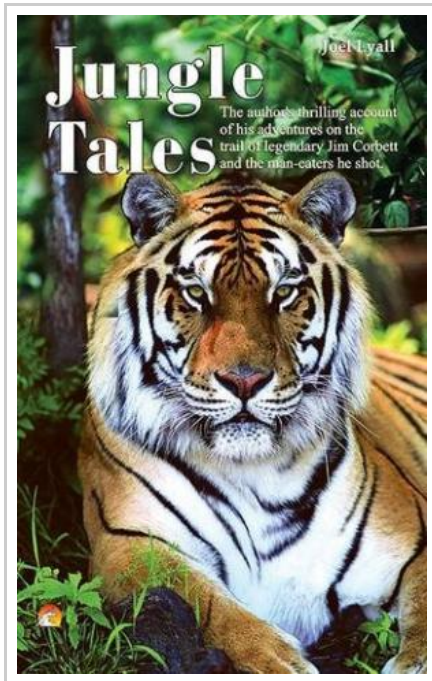




## Jungle Tales
