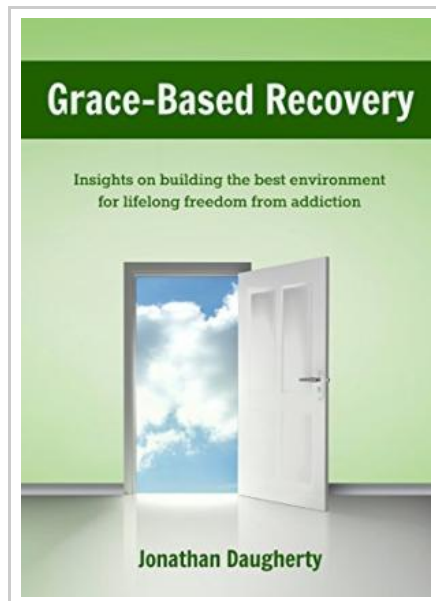




Grace-Based Recovery (Paperback)
