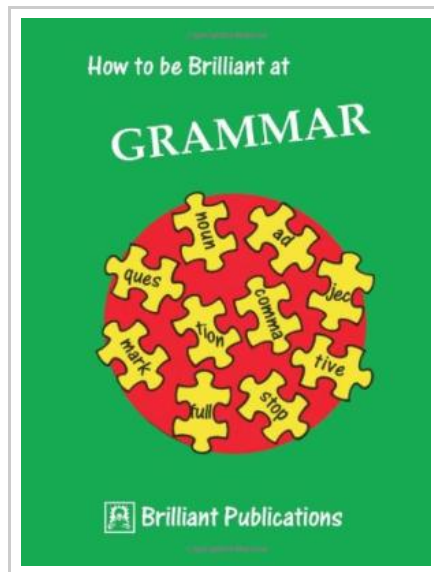




How to be Brilliant at Grammar (Paperback)
